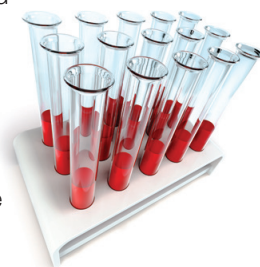


## ESR vs CRP

**Taranaki Medlab is processing considerably more ESRs than other laboratories in New Zealand.**

CRP is the preferred test when investigating a possible inflammatory or infective disorder and requesting both CRP and ESR is rarely appropriate. The exception is in the initial presentation of suspected giant cell arteritis (temporal arteritis) when both should be requested.

ESR has limitations in that it is also affected by the haemoglobin and plasma protein levels, and increases with age. The CRP has distinct reference ranges with no variation for age or gender, and is more sensitive to subtle changes in the acute phase response.
